

What: The Outreach Program for Soccer is a community-based recreational program specifically designed to help athletes with physical, cognitive, and developmental disabilities participate in the world's most popular sport.

TOPSoccer brings soccer to players who refuse to let their challenges stop them from playing the sport they love. The emphasis of this program is on learning soccer in a non-competitive environment. The basis of TOPSoccer is a modified version of the game of soccer, specifically altered to allow full participation and enjoyment for each athlete.

Who: People with Autism, wheelchair/walker enabled, ADD, ADHD, blind or partially-sighted, hard-of-hearing, deaf, non-verbal, developmentally disabled, etc. Anyone who is not able to play or keep up on a typical team... WE WANT YOU! TOPS accepts players ages 5 and older!

When: Fridays, April 5, 12, 19, 26 and May 3, 2019

Each practice will be 4:30-5:45 p.m. An end-of-the-season game will be held on May 10th or 12th!
